

## **Alcoholics Anonymous**

Alcoholics Anonymous is a treatment program for inmates dealing with issues of alcohol abuse. Outside AA volunteers come into the facility to coordinate meetings and discussions with inmates pursuing treatment for alcoholism and issues stemming from alcohol abuse. Individuals suffering with abuse issues for other substances are welcome to attend. Inmate participation is voluntary; however, inmates must sign in to verify their attendance for institutional and/or court purposes. At this time, the program is available to the sentenced population housed on the compound, with the exception of the MSB population. Detainees are not permitted to participate.

AA meetings are held weekly from 1745 hours to 1845 hours at two locations. Residents of the Key Building and the Program Building meet in the Program Building (the former Boot Camp). Residents of Merit, Minimum and Medium Buildings meet in the Program Center of the Pre-trial Building. Available seating may be limited, so entry into the meeting space is on a first-come, first-served basis.
